### Saharan North Africa

Endeavour took on everything the Sahara's dramatic and demanding landscape had in store.

As the world's largest desert, the Sahara is far more than 9.2 million km<sup>2</sup> of sand. Here, salt flats and 450-metre sand dunes join mountains and rocky plateaus. Temperatures range from highs that can reach 58°C right down to -6°C at night, making it one of the harshest climates on the planet.

For Endeavour, it's just another chapter in the adventure.

### Road to Reales

We took our newest campervan, the Endurance, on a big trip to Bardenas Reales, starting all the way from our HQ in Bristol.

With the challenging changes in climate from day to night, the Endurance delivered a comfortable and capable companion in this harsh semi-desert badlands. Coupled with its add on packs – being off-grid never felt more connected and catered for.




## Above, beyond -15 below

Cold chamber testing quickly separates the good from the great. Plunging our campervans into temperatures that hit -15°C outside whilst maintaining a +20°C inside shows that its construction and materials are more than up to it.








